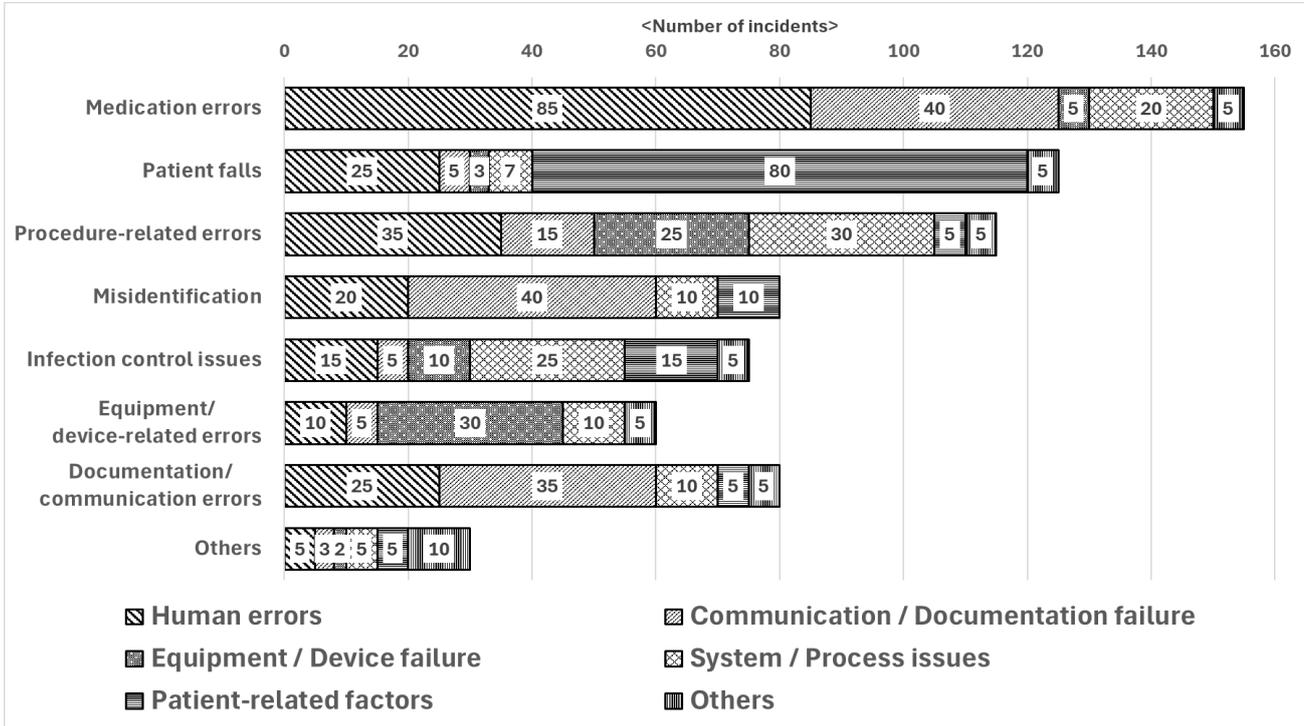


Figure 1. Distribution of Medical Incidents by Type and Cause at A Hospital, 2025

Categories of incident causes were defined as follows: Human error (e.g., lack of knowledge, inattention, insufficient confirmation, assumptions, mistakes due to routine work), Communication/Documentation failure (e.g., miscommunication, inadequate handover, incomplete or incorrect records), Equipment/Device failure (e.g., device malfunction, misuse, insufficient maintenance), System/Process issues (e.g., inadequate guidelines, staffing shortage, unclear procedures, environmental factors such as lighting or space), Patient-related factors (e.g., cognitive impairment, delirium, agitation, non-cooperation, unpredicted behaviors), and Others (causes not classified above).

The role of Advanced Practice Nurses (APNs) has become increasingly important in many healthcare systems. APNs are registered nurses with advanced education, usually at the master's level, who provide a higher level of clinical expertise. This group includes Nurse Practitioners (NPs), Clinical Nurse Specialists (CNSs), Nurse Midwives, and Nurse Anesthetists. APNs have been perceived to benefit patient care and experiences while reducing the workload of medical staff, and subsequently optimizing the cost-effectiveness and efficiency of health care services, and improving overall patient satisfaction. The main functions of APNs are to deliver advanced clinical services, lead patient education, and promote health. Depending on their specialty, they may assess and diagnose patients, prescribe treatments, or focus on consultation, research, and leadership. APNs are also vital members of multidisciplinary teams, coordinating care to ensure safety and efficiency.

Since the International Council of Nurses formally recognized the role, APNs have been introduced in many high-income countries such as the United States, United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand, and the Netherlands. Evidence shows that APNs provide care comparable to physicians, sometimes achieving superior outcomes in patient satisfaction, waiting times, management of chronic disease, and cost-effectiveness.

Despite these achievements, ①challenges remain. The scope of practice is often unclear, and certification standards vary widely. Collaboration with physicians can be difficult, and public awareness of APNs is still limited. Training programs and faculty members are also too few to meet healthcare demands.

Although APNs face these challenges, their contribution is widely recognized. They combine expert clinical care, education, and leadership, improving quality, access, and efficiency. In conclusion, while responsibilities differ internationally, APNs are essential in shaping the future of healthcare delivery.
