2025 Application for admission to the Graduate School of Nursing, Chiba University

Candidates applying for admission as research students at Chiba University Graduate School of Nursing may be admitted after screening by a selection committee. Please submit your application for admission as a research student following the procedure described below.

1. Qualifications for Application

Applicants must meet one of the following conditions:

- (1) Hold a master's or doctoral degree or a professional degree.
- (2) Have been awarded a master's or doctoral degree or degree equivalent to a professional degree in a foreign country.
- (3) Be recognized by the Graduate School of Nursing as having academic ability equivalent or superior to a master's or doctoral degree or a professional degree.

2. Admission and Application Period

Admission occurs at the beginning of each semester (April or October). In principle, the enrollment period is one year, but may be extended upon request.

3. Documents to be submitted:

- (1) Application form for admission (form provided by the Graduate School) (Note) Please obtain the signature of your academic advisor at the Graduate School in advance.
- (2) Curriculum vitae (form provided by the Graduate School)
- (3) Certificate of completion and academic transcripts from the last school attended
- (4) Letter of Recommendation? (form provided by the Graduate School)
- (5) Examination fee 9,800 yen

(Note) Before applying, please visit your nearest bank, etc. (excluding Japan Post Bank) and transfer the application fee over the counter (automatic transfer machines are not accepted) using the designated form in this application guidebook (bank transfer request form). The transfer must be completed by wire transfer, and paid by the applicant. Please ensure that the receipt bears the stamp/seal of the financial institution upon emission, as the stamp/seal certifies its validity.

Period of payment:

First semester: February 3, 2025 (Monday) to February 12, 2025 (Wednesday) Second semester: August 1, 2025 (Fri.) - August 20, 2025 (Wed.)

- (6) Envelope for result notification (dimensions 120x235mm, clearly addressed to the candidate, and stamped to the value of 110 yen)
- (7) Application form and Curriculum Vitae for International Students (form prescribed by the Graduate School)
- (8) Copy of the certificate of residence juminhyou (only for applicants residing in Japan at the time of application)

(Note) Issued by the municipality (with the status of residence and period of stay indicated).

Those who are not registered as a resident should submit a copy of their passport.

The copy of the passport shall include the person's name, date of birth, gender, the part indicating status of residence, and the part of the Japanese visa.

(Note) Please submit a copy of the resident card that does not include the applicant's personal number.

4. Admission process

- (1) After screening, those who have been admitted to the Graduate School will be notified by mail.
- (2) Those who have been notified in accordance with the preceding paragraph will be required to pay the following fees.
 - ① Enrollment fee: 84,600 yen (Only at the time of admission)
 - ② Tuition fee 173,400 yen (for half a year)

Note #1. If the enrollment fee is revised by the time of admission, the new fee will be applied from the revised date.

Note #2. If the tuition fee is revised by the time of admission or while the student is enrolled, the new tuition fee will be applied from the time of the revision.

(3) A Letter of Acceptance will be issued to those who have paid the entrance and tuition fees.
