2-8. 成果発表会

最終の学習成果発表会は、予定通り、oVice を使用して、2023 年 3 月 16 日の午後に開催した。学習目標および学習ガイド等に沿った内容として、表 14 のような構成として行った。 グループ毎に、トピックに沿って学習成果をまとめ、プレゼンテーションを行った。 インド SIU および千葉大学からの参加学生計 20 名に加え、関係者が参加した、総勢 30 名程度での開催となった。

organization/facility of each field, social issues being addressed, target people for services, actual support/service activities, goal and evaluation criteria for services (if any), activities carried out by students, good points and well-designed approach, suggestions or new ideas for improvements or remaining problem, transferability to home country and reasons for it.

3. Self-evaluation as a team - 5 minutes

Presentation of overall evaluation of IPCP as a team, and its dependence on the situation, future issues, and prospects.

li. Q&A: After each team's presentation, there will be 10 minutes of Q&A time. Presentation time per team: 15 minutes + Q&A time of 10 minutes = 25 minutes.

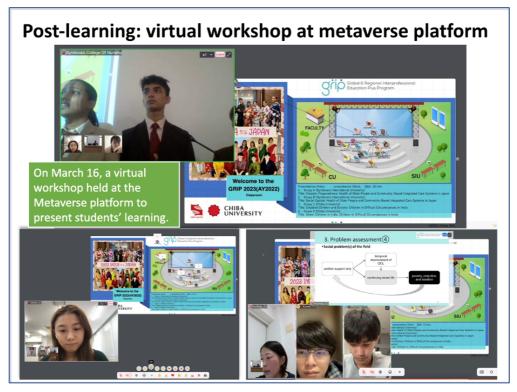


図 21 実際の発表時の画面の様子
